In these ten years, our club started organising long term service projects. The first one was Recovery Village for Drug Abusers at Wu Oi Christian Centre. We organised this project from 1981 to 1987. The second long term project was child sponsorship programme of Po Leung Kuk. The first child was sponsored from 1984 to 1988. The third one was Hong Kong Youth Culture and Arts Competitions. With the invitation from Leo Club of Hong Kong Island, we have been being the examiners in the competition since 1982!

We still organised dance ball for raising our services fund. The dance ball was held in Mariner's Club which was a famous club in 1980's. Besides dance ball, we started organising various kinds of fund raising activities such as Folk Song Show, Film Show and Walkathon, etc.

Camping was the major activity for training and recruitment. We also organised leadership training courses for the members and observers. We had participated in the training course of Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups "Money and Life" Questionnaire Project. We also had BBQ fellowship and Folk Song activity in this period.

Leo District was chartered on 17 June 1979. Our members have been actively involved in Leo District by serving as officers and committee chairpersons. We also actively involved in Leo District activities such as fellowship, training, joint meeting and projects. We had the first Leo District President, Leo Bonap Man, from our Club in 1987-1988. Our club, as usual, involved in Lions District activities such as Lions Service Day, Lions Walk and OSEAL Forum, etc.

The highlight of these ten years should be the youth exchange programme. Our members joined the youth exchange camps in various countries such as Japan, Taiwan, Sri Lanka and U.S.A. Also, we had foreign Leos from Germany and Austria visiting Hong Kong. Another milestone was the Twinning with Leo Club of Kuala Lumpur Central on 19 April 1987.
